Various Campus Plazas - NYC DEP Grants

RDA designed and oversaw construction of a new Alumni plaza and ceremonial gateway on the eastern Great Lawn of the campus in 2008.

In 2011, RDA and Queens College won Green Infrastructure Grants from the NYC Dept. of Environmental Protection to develop permeable paver plazas and rain gardens. These plazas were designed to absorb and recharge stormwater directly into the ground, thus eliminating close to one-million gallons of stormwater from entering the City combined sewer system.

In 2013, RDA again won a Grant from the NYC DEP for a similar plaza outside the campus Dining Hall. This project will be completed in 2014.
